SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

SUMMARY: To authorize imposition of a local sales and service tax in the cities of Clive, Urbandale, Waukee and West Des Moines, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective July 1, 2018.

A local sales and service tax shall be imposed in the cities of Clive, Urbandale, Waukee and West Des Moines, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective July 1, 2018.

Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

FOR THE CITY OF CLIVE:

Fifty percent (50%) for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended is:

1. Fifty percent (50%) for capital projects including, but not limited to, street improvements, park and trail improvements, public safety facilities and storm water improvements.

FOR THE CITY OF URBANDALE:

Fifty percent (50%) for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended is:

1. Fifty percent (50%) capital improvement projects which may include, but is not limited to, public safety facilities, aquatic center, street improvements, park and trail improvements, storm water improvements, and related debt retirement.

FOR THE CITY OF WAUKEE:

Fifty percent (50%) for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended is:

1. Fifty percent (50%) of such revenues for city quality of life improvement purposes, including but not limited to recreational/sports complexes, community center, trails, parks, arts, cultural amenities, historic preservation, and for public uses the city deems appropriate.

FOR THE CITY OF WEST DES MOINES:

Fifty percent (50%) for property tax reduction.

The specific purpose for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended is:

1. Fifty percent (50%) of revenue will be applied directly to the construction of public parks, recreational facilities and trails; public infrastructure construction; and public safety expenditures.
