PUBLIC NOTICE OF ELECTION is hereby given pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 423B you are hereby notified that on March 6, 2018 an election will be held in Polk County to vote on the question of imposition of a Local Option Sales and Services tax. The Proposal to be voted upon at this election will be in substantially the form listed within this publication.

Imposition question for voters in City of Bondurant, in the County of Polk, State of Iowa, will be voting on Public Measure Letter A.

The polls will be open from 7:00 AM until 8:00 PM at the following Polling Places:

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. For further information, please contact the Polk County Election Office at 286-3247 or election@polkcountyiowa.gov. Public Machine testing will commence Tuesday, February 20 and continue until Monday, March 5 at each precinct.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. Pre-registered voters who are unable to show approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. Any voter that cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has a proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present approved form of identification.
